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COMMON SENSE NOTES SAFETY

Please use the safety lights and co-ordinate with other shooters prior to stepping ahead of the firing line. We are safer when we work together.

Please wear your ID tag when at the range.

When you have finished your shooting session, please remove any targets that you put up. Also, sweep up any brass that may be a hazard to anyone walking along the firing line shooting area. Lets keep the range clean for the next shooter.

For those who access the padlock at the gate, please scramble the code after opening and after closing the gate.
